Victor Koretzky: "I'm having a great year"

"I got off to a good start because we saw in the other races that you had to be well placed right away. I let the two Swiss go by because I was afraid of going into the red too early, I think I did well because I still had a lot of resources at the end of the race. I think I managed my effort well. When I got back to Cink (a lap and a half from the finish) I didn't stay with him long, I attacked him in the technical part of the circuit, and he didn't follow. Approaching the finish, I still had some power on the pedal.



This third place gives even more strength to my season, I'm having a great year, even if I didn't want to go to the Olympic Games to be 5th, but to get a medal. I've got that medal today, and it shows that I can be counted on for big goals. This is

my first in the Elites, after the juniors and the U21s, so it definitely has a special flavor."
